### **HDEV 0092 AND 1300**

If these are some of the thoughts and questions that you have had, then you might benefit from taking the course HDEV 0092 or 1300 – Learning skills that are also life skills.

HDEV 0092/1300 is a three credit hour course dealing with learning issues as well as a variety of reading and study strategies and tactics from time management to test taking. Several sections are offered in the fall, spring and summer semesters. The typical class size is normally smaller which allows the student to participate in group interaction as well as individual attention.
